

MOTOR VEHICLE CONSENT

(Use of private motor vehicles by teacher/students on school activities)

CONDITIONS

- i) The Principals consent must be gained before any student or staff member uses their motor vehicle to transport students to a school activity. This is a rare concession that may be withdrawn at any stage by the Principal.
- ii) Cars can be driven to or from school activities by students only with written parental consent.
- iii) Teachers / student drivers are expected to conform to the road rules at all times and to ensure that no more passengers are carried than are provided for by fitted seat belts.
- iv) No student may travel as a passenger in a car driven by another student to or from school activates without written parental consent.
- v) Teachers / students driving vehicles must hold a valid driver's license.
- vi) Vehicles being driven by students must have <u>current registration</u> and <u>current comprehensive and third party property insurance</u> and have seat belts fitted for all passengers.
- vii) Teachers / student drivers should not charge passengers a fare since this may invalidate their insurance policies.
- viii) Other rules relating to parking, visiting cars during school hours, etc., at the discretion of the Principal or the venue attending must be followed.
