Dear Parent/Caregiver,

On Wednesday, 31st May 2023, East Hills Boys High School will be running its annual School Athletics carnival. The carnival is a compulsory school event and each student is expected to attend. There will be NO normal lessons at school on this day.

All students will be required to attend school for roll call in the quadrangle at 8.47am. Roll call teachers will then escort all students to the buses outside the school, which will transport students to the Crest Athletics Centre at Bass Hill.

At the completion of the athletics events, a final roll call will take place and all students will then return to school via the buses, with an approximate return time of 3.00pm.

Parents please note: NO student will be allowed to leave the venue early. If you intend to pick up your son from the venue, a written permission note must be presented prior to the day.

VENUE:

The Crest Athletics Centre, Bass Hill

TRAVEL:

All students travel to and from the carnival by bus under the supervision of teachers.

COST:

\$10 per student (During roll call on Tuesday, 23rd May the Roll Call teacher will collect the \$10 and

the permission note from each student. A receipt will then be given to your son during roll call.)

ITEMS:

Bag, Hat, Sunscreen, Water Bottle, Lunch, Spikes (Optional).

*A sausage sizzle will take place during the day and some canteen facilities will be available, however, students are encouraged to bring their own lunch.
