- Solar My School – site evaluated and waiting on report. Likely solar on G block and those with new roofs.
- New roofs for M,E & F Blocks. Whilst being replaced there was rain which leaked into classroom and caused water damage to laser printer and electrical equipment. Roofing contractor to replace equipment.
- Very little will change for our school under the Departments enrolment policy at this stage. Student numbers significantly increasing with 170 enrolments for Yr 7 and total of 850 students in 2020. School can be selective in new out of area enrolments in future.

Treasurers report: \$32,489.12 in the bank.
